- **The Giza Pyramid and the Great Sphinx** near Cairo, Egypt is a symbol of the high culture of the dynasty of ancient Egypt.
- **The Taj Mahal** is a monument of eternal love, and a symbol for India. It was built by Mughal emperor Shah Jahan in memory of his third wife.
- **Stonehenge** in Wiltshire, England is the world's most famous prehistoric monument. People consider it a sacred site and associate the ceremonial place with the super natural world.
- **The Colosseum** in Rome, Italy is an iconic symbol for Rome the 'Eternal City' as well as for the civilization of the Imperial Roman Empire.

- **The Leaning Tower of Pisa** in Pisa Italy, of a result of a massive miscalculation. This 'mistake' weighs in at 14,500 tonnes. It is situated behind the Cathedral and is the third oldest structure in Pisa's Cathedral Square.
- **The Clock Tower**, Palace of Westminster, London United Kingdom, is a symbol for London as well as an icon for the British way of life.
- **Empire State Building**, Manhattan, New York City, USA, the art deco building is a popular landmark and rose during the Great Depression to the then tallest building in the world.
- **Mount Rushmore**, South Dakota, USA. The four presidents carved in the mountain are George Washington, Thomas Jefferson, Theodore Roosevelt, and Abraham Lincoln. Thomas Jefferson was originally started on George Washington's right. However, after 18 months they realized that it was not working. Jefferson's face was dynamited off and carved on the other side.
