

## OWL PHOTO HOLDER CRAFT

#### Supplies Needed:

- Owl Card Templates on white cardstock (Body/Wings/Half-sheet with eyes, nose/beak, pupils, eyelids (cut the circle in half to make two semicircles))
- Brass fasteners (you'll need 2 for the craft but there's an extra one in the kit)
- Photo of your choice
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Materials to color/decorate the owl with
- Halloween sticker for decorating (if you'd like)

## Tutorial:

### 1. Print & cut out template

Cut out all of the template pieces.

### 2. Make wings

Line up the wings on the owl body, punch a hole with a hole punch and insert and close a metal paper fastener into the hole on both sides.



### 3. Decorate your owl

Use markers to draw feathers on the wings and inside the owl body. You could also draw hearts on the inside of the owl body, or you can draw things for Halloween.

### 4. Glue on eyes & beak

Cut out two white circle eyes, two black circle pupils, an orange owl beak and two half-circle eyelids for your owl. Glue them onto your owl body.



## 5. Add photo

Cut down a child's photo to fit and glue it down at the bottom of the owl body. Maybe use a photo of you in your Halloween costume? Add the Halloween sticker if you want to make the owl more Halloweenish!

**TIP: Use the back of the owl card for a place to write a personal message for someone for Halloween if you'd like.**
