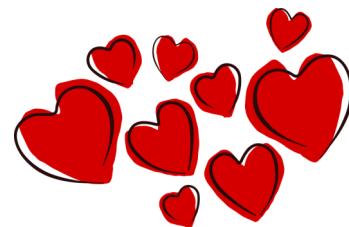


The Heart Song

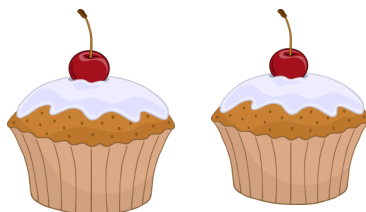
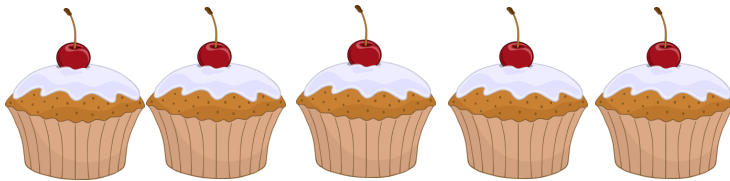

And eat it all together!



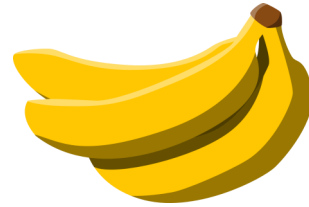

Raccoon, Possum, and Rabbit – Song by Dan Zanes & Elizabeth Mitchell

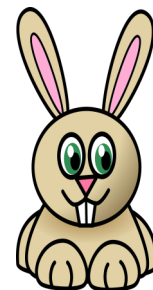
Raccoon's got a bushy tail, Possum's tail goes bare
