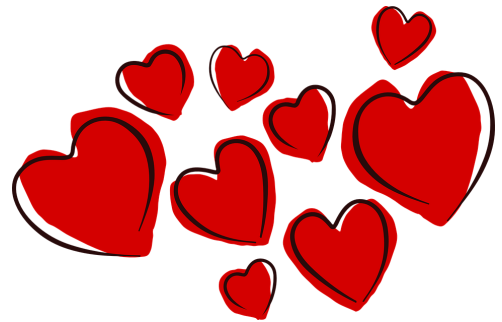
### **Opening Rhyme: Hello Friends**

With a moo-moo here, and a moo-moo there,

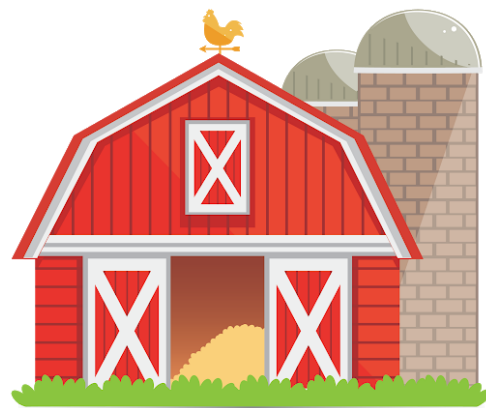
Here a moo, there a moo, everywhere a moo-moo.

The Cat has a Mouse ...

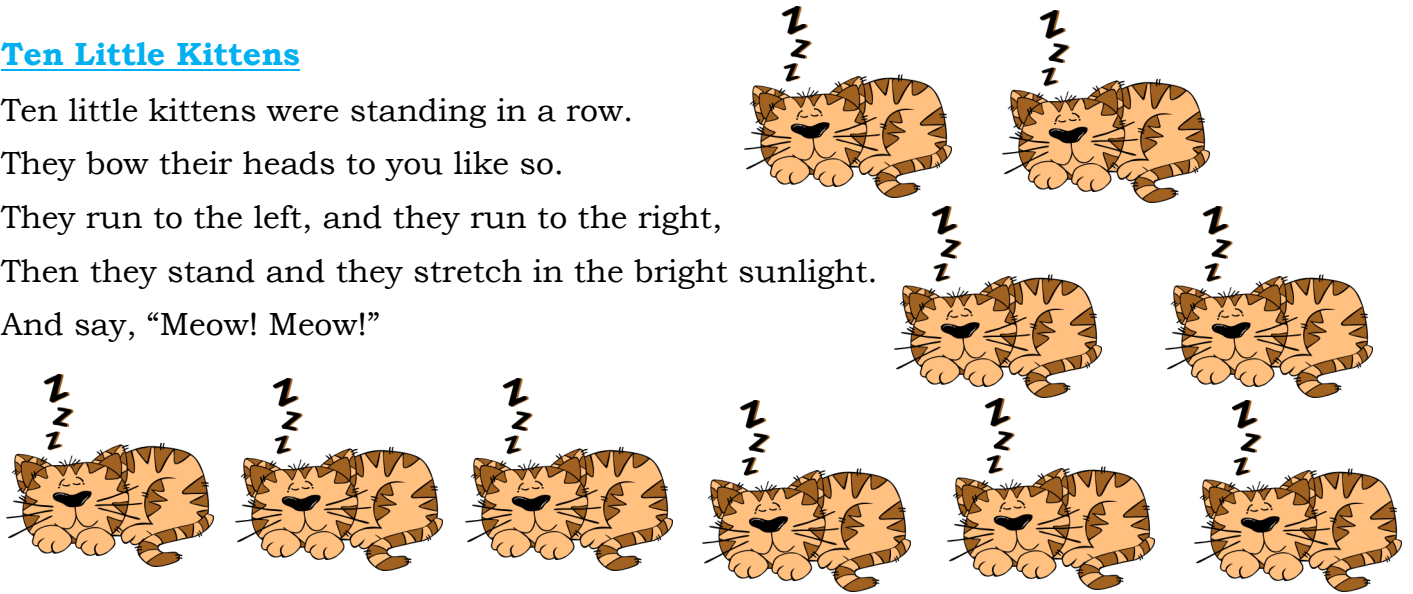
The Mouse has some Cheese ...

And say, "Meow! Meow!"

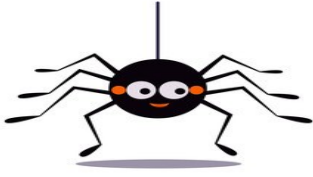


### I Love My Rooster – Adapted from the Laurie Berkner Band version

Deedoodle-eedoodle-eedoodle-eedoo!

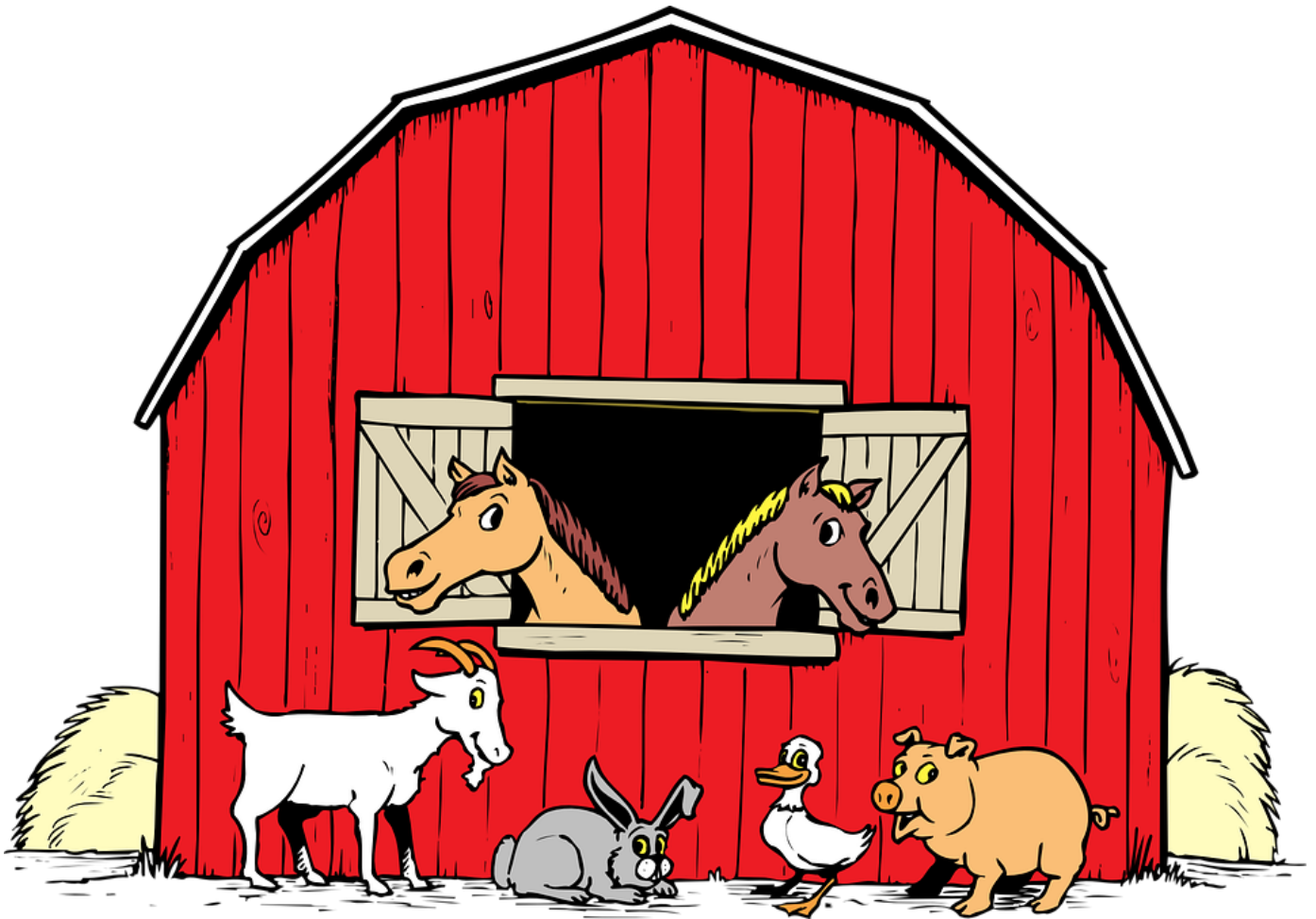






### **The Itsy-Bitsy Spider**
