(say child's name)



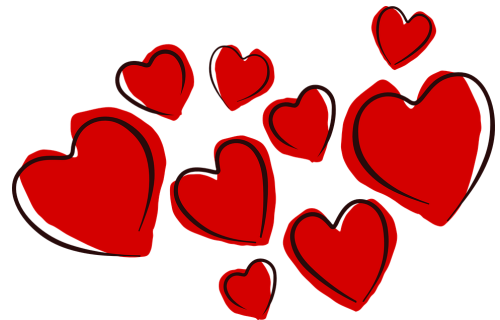
The Heart Song

Ten Little Kittens

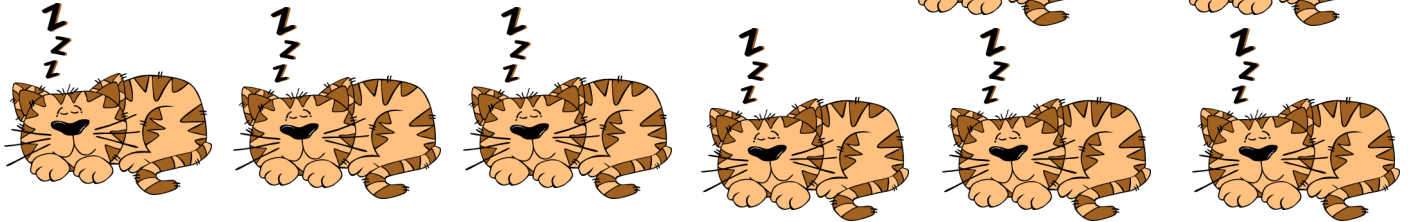
Ten little kittens were standing in a row.

Purr and purr!

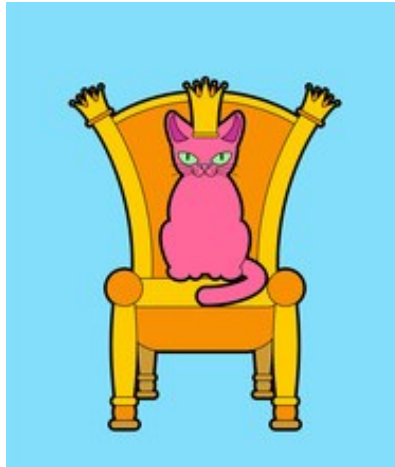


Kitty Cat, Kitty Cat - Adapted Traditional

To visit the King.

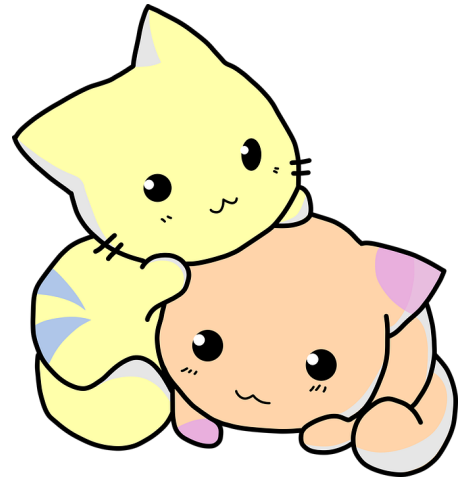
Kitty cat, kitty cat,
