I bring my fingers down like this —

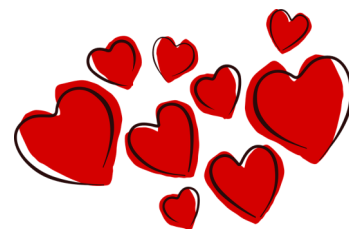
And now I have a heart!

One little, two little three little hearts,

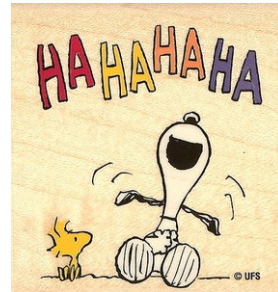
Four little, five little, six little hearts,

And the dish ran away with the spoon!

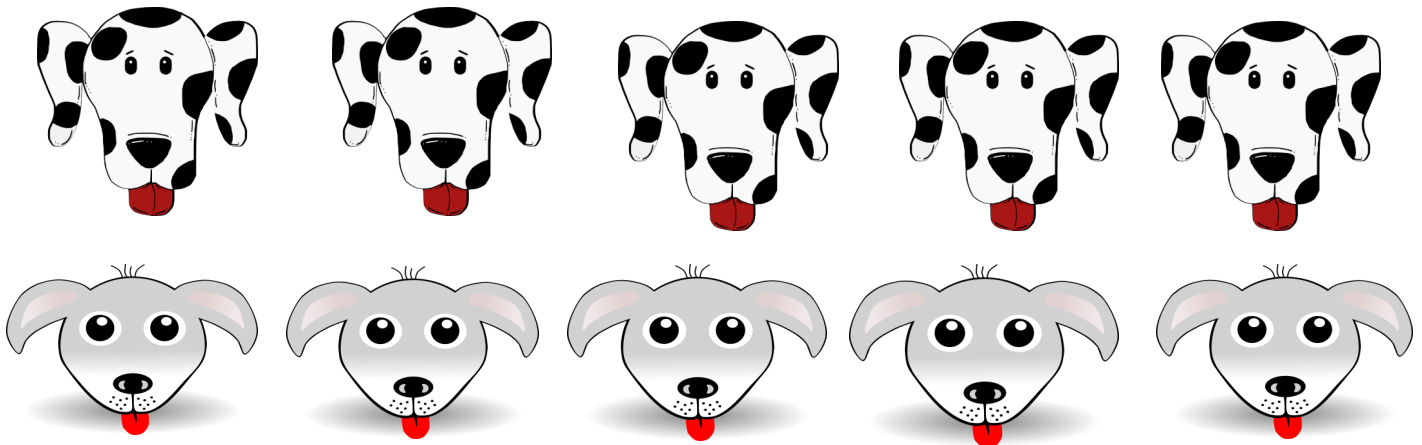

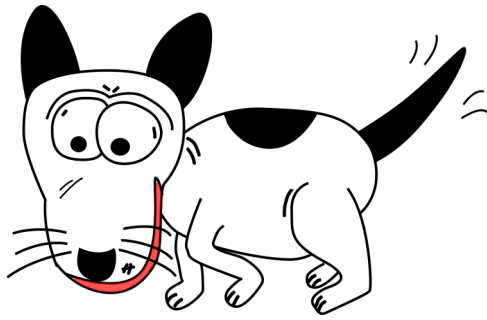
Love, love, love your pets

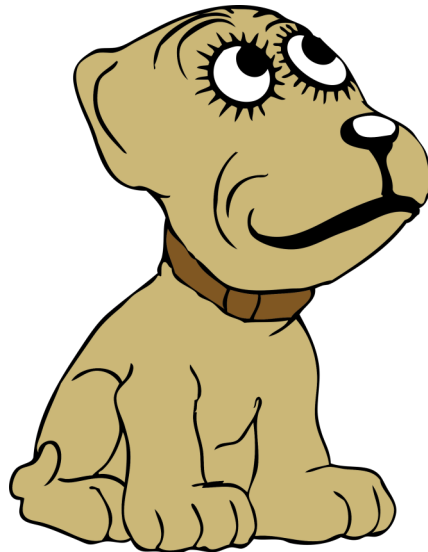

The driver on the bus says, "Move on back..."

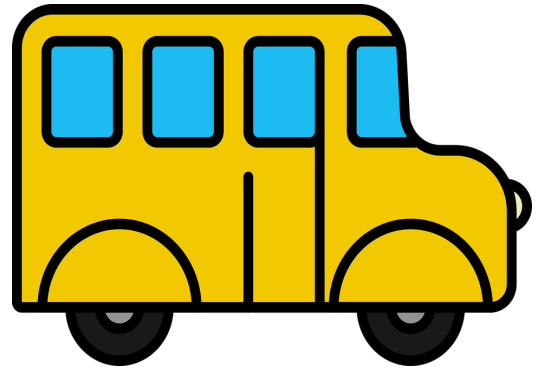
The horn on the bus goes beep, beep, beep...
