I put on my glasses, [lift pretend glasses up]

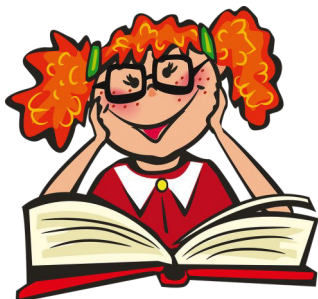
And open up my book! [open pretend book]

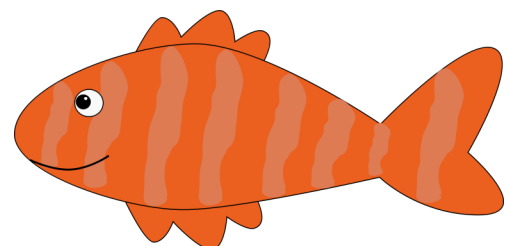

Row, row, row your boat gently down the river,

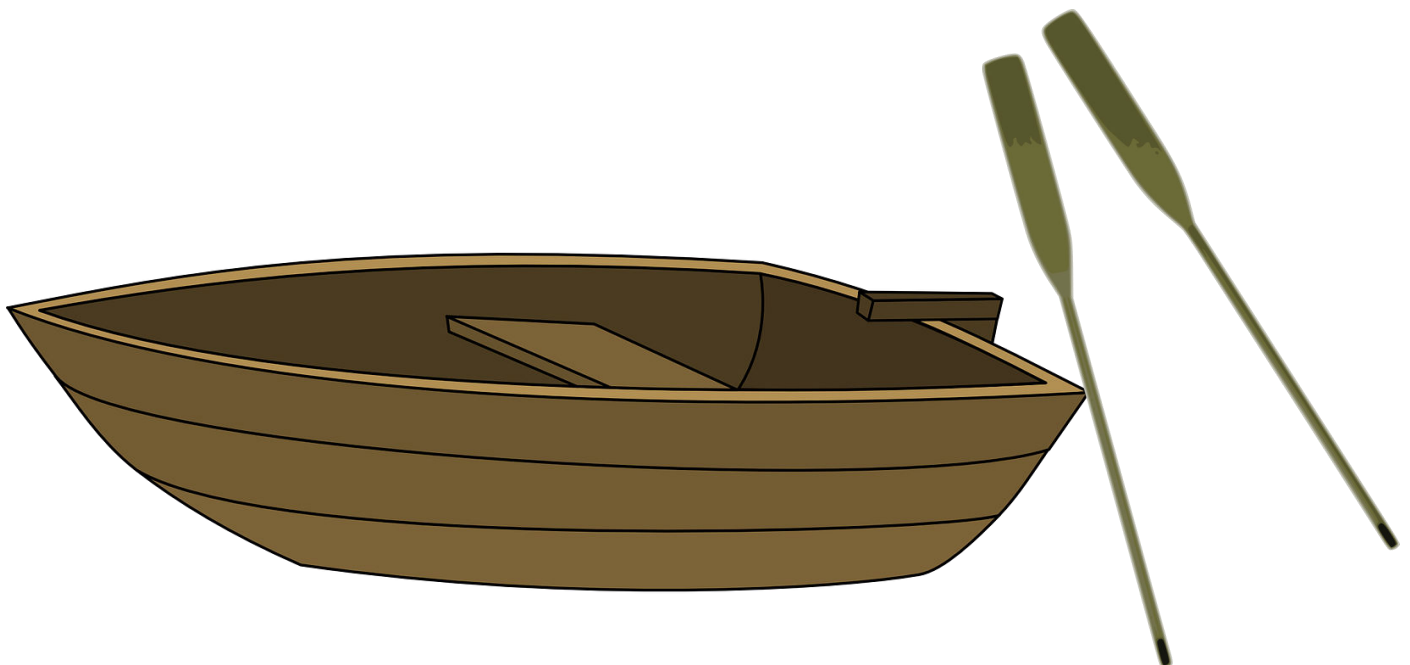
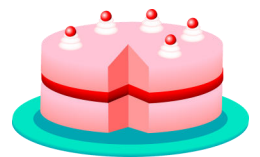
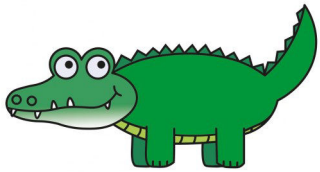
If you see a polar bear, don't forget to shiver!

If you see some friends of yours, stop and share some cake!



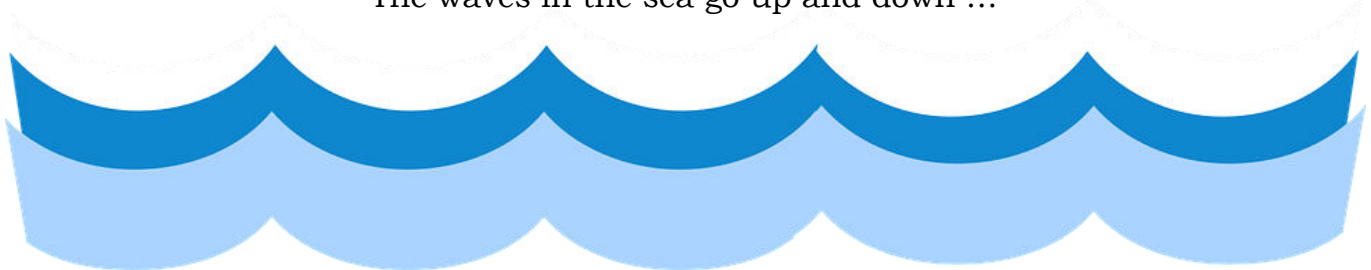


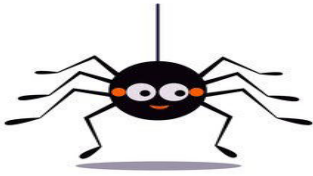
### Zoom, Zoom, Zoom

The waves in the sea go up and down ...



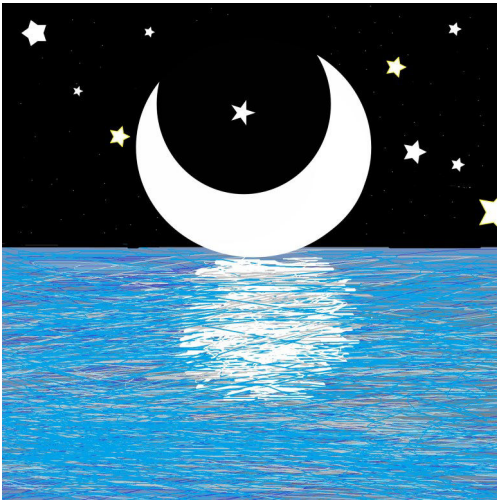
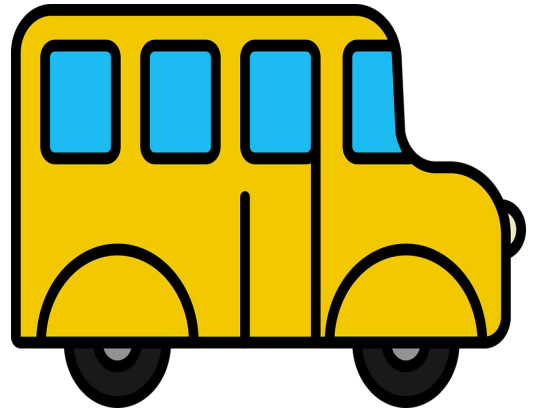


### **The Itsy-Bitsy Spider**
