And we'll look, look, look. [put on glasses and look from side to side]

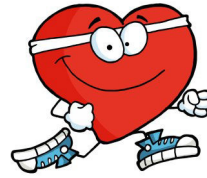
Then we'll put down our glasses, [take off glasses]

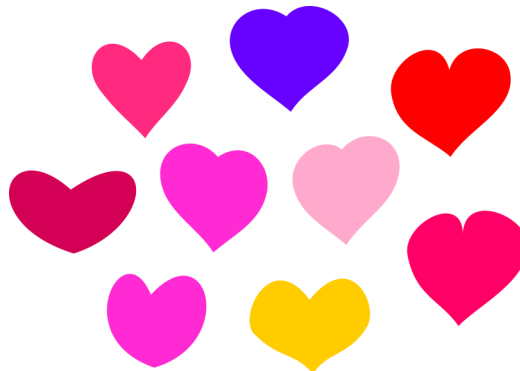

I love my friends, and my friends love me.

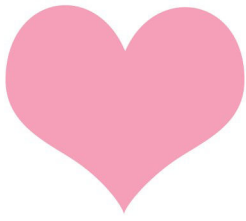
And I feed my friends on the green-berry tree.

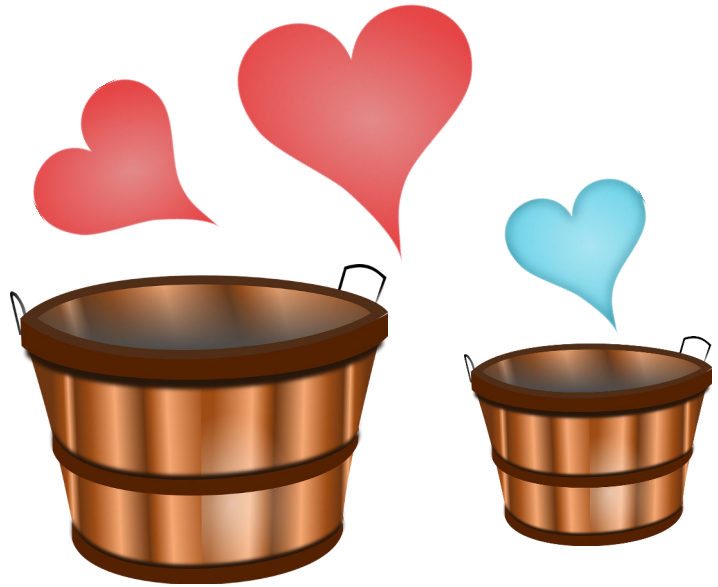

I Love You A Bushel and A Peck

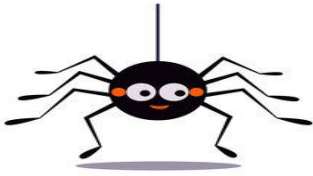
I love you, a bushel and a peck,

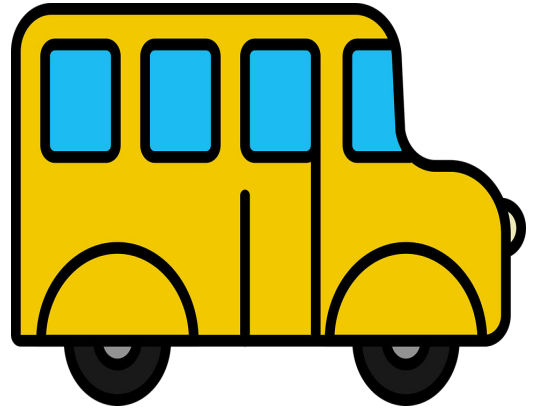


The Itsy-Bitsy Spider
