And [clap!] close up the book! [close the book]

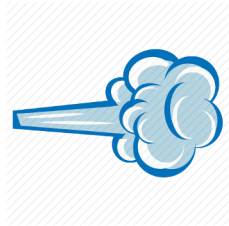
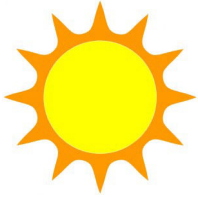
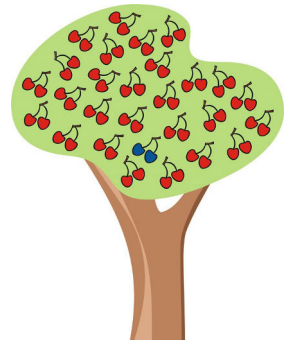
## Cuckoo, Cuckoo, Cherry Tree

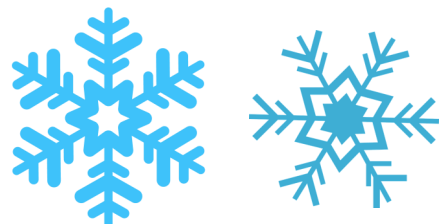

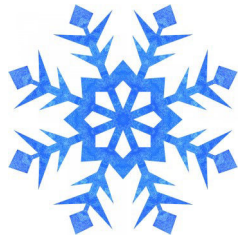

Bump bump bump bump bump!

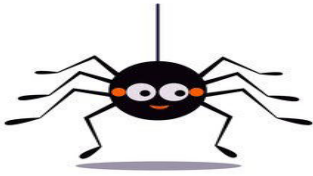

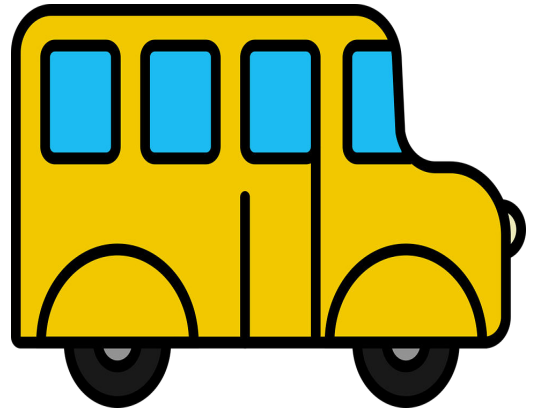


### **The Itsy-Bitsy Spider**
