I put on my glasses, [lift pretend glasses up]


And open up my book! [open pretend book]

And we'll look, look, look. [put on glasses and look from side to side]


Then we'll put down our glasses, [take off glasses]

And children run round and round!




Goldie Goldfish – from the song by Debbie Clement





Once I Saw An Octopus – Rhyme From Preschool Education

Five and six and seven and eight.




Row, Row, Row Your Boat

The waves in the sea go up and down ...






The Itsy-Bitsy Spider
